




FIRST-TIME VOTING RESTRICTIONS 2016 PRES. ELECTION

Why Is This A Problem For All? The Ripple Effect

REASON 1 Constitutional Convention

Article V of the U.S. Constitution: States can convene a Constitutional Convention if two-thirds (34) of their legislatures pass a resolution in favor of doing so.


